### **B**NERIS

#### **CoonGoo: Scope**

- Working Group on Contaminated Goods created in 2002 (3rd NERIS General Assembly in Glasgow, 15 May, 2012)
- Overall objective: contribute to the development of strategies, guidance and tools for the management of the contaminated products
- Taking into account the experience countries after the accidents of Chernobyl and Fukushima

Link with the EC PREPARE Project : in particular WP 3 dedicated to the management of contaminated goods (foodstuff/feedstuff and other consumer goods) taking into account the view points of all stakeholders(producers, processing and retail industries, consumers, NGO..)<sup>2</sup>

## **BRIS** ConGoo: Main Activities

- Second Meeting in Madrid: 22 May 2013
  60 participants 12 presentations (European national experiences and experiences from Chernobyl and Fukushima + regulation context in the different countries)
- 2013-2015: Work in progress through PREPARE WP 3

## **BREPARE WP3 Progress**

- 11 European countries involved in PREPARE WP3 (Belgium, France, Finland, Greece, Ireland, Netherlands, Norway, Portugal, Switzerland, Spain, UK) → A common methodology : Stakeholders' panels in 10 countries
- 3 Task Force Meetings with participation of all partners and Japanese colleagues (Univ. of Fukushima, CRIEPI)

→ First Task Force Meeting in Madrid (23 May 2013): Discussion of a common framework with the specification of panel methodology in each country

→ Second Task Meeting in Athens (26-28 May 2014): Presentation of the 10 national first results

→Third Task Force Meeting in Dublin (End of May, 2015)

## **B**NERIS



 Proposal to organize an open <u>Workshop in Autumn 2015</u> in Paris dedicated to post-accident management of the contaminated products

#### **Opportunity to**:

- discuss PREPARE WP3 results (Panels' insights in 10 countries), in the presence of national stakeholders

- invite Japanese colleagues and stakeholders involved in the management of contaminated products (*CRIEPI, Fukushima University, involved Producers and Consumers,...*)

- share results with international organisations (*EC-DG Ener, FAO, EFSA, WHO, OECD-NEA, IAEA, HERCA, IRCP, CRPPH,...*) and with post-accident networks (*NERIS,...*)
