OPERRA: Concept & Main Objectives

- To build up an umbrella coordination structure that has the capacity in a legal and logistical sense to administer future calls for research in radiation protection on behalf of the European Commission
- The MELODI Association will take the lead with the support of sister structures as equal partners (e.g. Alliance, NERIS, EURADOS, EURAMET, EUTERP, etc.)





OPERRA will adopt a multi-level strategy:

- Holding expert meetings/workshops on selected topics
- **Publishing** the outcomes from these meetings
- Providing input to the MELODI Association on how to integrate the results and recommendations derived from the expert meetings into the further implementation of a European umbrella structure integrating and coordinating research activities in radiation protection
- Organising competitive calls for research projects in radiation protection based upon Strategic Research Agendas

- emergency response,
- remediation measures and
- health impact will be described.





Objectives of task 2.3

They will be prioritised with regards to health impact.
