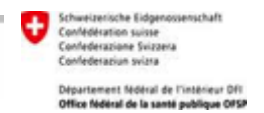
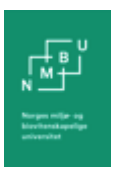


Final Workshop of the European Research Project PREPARE WP3 on “Management of Contaminated Goods after a nuclear accident”
