

NERIS Topical Workshop on the Management of Contaminated Goods Wednesday 22 May 2013 – CIEMAT - Madrid, Spain

This topical workshop is organised at the initiative of the NERIS Working Group on Contaminated Goods, focussing on international experiences in the management of contaminated foodstuff and other goods after Chernobyl and Fukushima accidents and particularly in Japan, Belarus, Norway and the UK: experts and other stakeholders from these countries have been invited for presenting their feedback on these issues. International organisations (e.g. IAEA, EC, FAO, NEA-OECD) are also expected to share their recent international experiences in the management, monitoring and radioactivity control of goods coming from Japan. At the end of the workshop, a round table will be organised to discuss the lessons learned and challenges for the management of contaminated goods.
