Objectives of the Workshop

The NERIS Workshop 2019 will focus on "Key challenges in the preparedness for emergency response and recovery of a nuclear or radiological event" as well as on common topics with international organisations and Radiation Protection Platforms.

This will be an opportunity to **discuss and exchange views** with NERIS Members, international organisations and European Research communities on research developments and priorities for the European NERIS Platform.

4 main topics selected

Plenary sessions will be organised on topics related to the following challenges:

- Radiological impact assessment during all phases of nuclear and radiological events
- Countermeasures and countermeasure strategies in emergency & recovery, decision support & disaster informatics
- Setting-up a trans-disciplinary and inclusive framework for preparedness for emergency response and recovery

In addition, a specific session will be held on:

 Challenges in estimating the source term and operational radiological picture (on-site versus off-site)

Venue

The Workshop will take place on the DTU **Risø Campus**, near the city of Roskilde, located in north central Zealand (Denmark), only 30 km from Copenhagen.

DTU Nutech has inherited the mission as Denmark's national competence center for nuclear technologies from the former Risø National Laboratory.

The Programme Committee issues a special invitation to **young scientists and professionals** to attend the NERIS Workshop as participants. For the second time, the NERIS Platform has decided to set up the '**NERIS Young Scientist Award'**, to promote young people whose professional or scientific works have been noted for their quality and originality. This is also an opportunity for young researchers to present their work in an oral form to an experienced audience of international experts.

To compete for this award, candidates are required to:

- be under 35 years by April 2019;
- be the main author of a paper whose abstract has been approved by the Programme Committee;
- mention on the abstract submission that they wish to compete for the 'NERIS Young Scientist Award'.

🏆 Award

The award winner will be selected according to criteria established by the Programme Committee. The award will be announced and presented at the end of the 5th NERIS Workshop, and will consist of a diploma and a free registration to the next NERIS Workshop.
