Getting to Risø campus

From the airport 💥

By car

Distance : 50 km ≈ 40-50 minutes trip.



By taxi 🚔

Copenhagen Airport or Copenhagen Main Station to Roskilde: approx. DKK 750 (≈ 100€).

From Roskilde Railway Station to Risø: approx. DDK 180 (≈24€). Phone taxi: 4675 7575 or 3535 3535.

By public transportation 🚐

Count more than 50 minutes by public transportation to travel the 40 km. Use <u>the Journey Planner</u> to plan your trip to DTU Risø Campus (station Risø Frederiksborgvej).

By train 🚂

! You need to have a ticket before boarding a train. Train and metro tickets can be purchased at the DSB ticket office in Terminal 3.

- The train to/from Copenhagen Central Station (København H) every 10 minutes departure from Platform 2.
- From Copenhagen Central Station (København H) Platform 8 departures at regular intervals towards Roskilde - travelling time approx. 25 minutes.

By bus:

! You can buy your ticket at the driver only by cash (no bankcards).

At Roskilde station you can board bus 600S on the southern side of the railway station in Østergade. In case you are coming from the downtown (north), you have to use the underpass to cross the rails. You need the bus towards Hillerød and have to take off at DTU Risø Campus.

Accommodation

Please be aware that accommodation in Roskilde is highly demanded at this period, don't wait to book rooms !

Zleep Hotel (https://www.zleephotels.com/en/hotel/roskilde/)

This hotel is situated in the main street of Roskilde and in walking distance from the train station Roskilde. You can take bus 600S (towards Hillerød) from the Roskilde main station to DTU Risø Campus.

This hotel is situated approx. ½ km from the centre of Roskilde. You can take bus 600S (towards Hillerød) from the Roskilde main station to DTU Risø Campus.



Hotel Søfryd

This hotel is situated in a village named Jyllinge about 20 km from Roskilde towards Hillerød. The hotel is on bus 600S line.

Comwell Roskilde

This hotel is rather near DTU Risø Campus - you need to take a taxi (too long to walk) to DTU Risø Campus (or bus 216 from Terrasserne, but it runs just once an hour).

Danhostel

(http://www.danhostelroskilde.dk/)

The hostel is located in Roskilde's harbour along the Roskilde Fjord. The Roskilde Cathedral is a 10minute walk away and Roskilde main station is a ca. 20 minutes walk away. You can take bus 600S (towards Hillerød) from the Roskilde main station to DTU Risø Campus.

Accommodation outside of Roskilde

Quality Hotel Høje Taastrup (https://qualityhotel-hojetastrup.h-rez.com)

This hotel is located appr. 15 km from Roskilde (towards Copenhagen). Travel time by train from Høje Taastrup train station to Roskilde is 12 min. The train station is in walking distance from the hotel. You can also take the bus from the same station (**Høje Taastrup St.**).

Things to do in Roskilde

Roskilde:

Located 30 km west of Copenhagen on the Danish island of Zealand, is the main city in Roskilde Municipality. Roskilde has a long history, dating from the pre-Christian Viking Age.



• Roskilde Cathedral:

A cathedral of the Lutheran Church of Denmark. The first Gothic cathedral to be built of brick, it encouraged the spread of the Brick Gothic style throughout Northern Europe. The cathedral has been the main burial site for Danish monarchs since the 15th century. Since 1995, it has been listed as a UNESCO World Heritage Site.



Viking ship museum in Roskilde: The Viking Ship Museum in Roskilde is Denmark's national museum for ships, seafaring and boatbuilding in the prehistoric and medieval period. The main focus of the museum is a permanent exhibition of five original Viking ships excavated nearby in 1962.
